1. You'll need a window box (or two if you've got the space) with drainage holes

- 2. Use peat-free compost in your window box
- 3. Stock up on pollinator friendly plants that are suitable for window boxes. Choose from:

Lavender Early Crocus Thyme Agrimony Rosemary Sage

4. Water regularly over spring and summer







1. Identify a strip of your garden border that you can keep just for pollinators

- 2. Dig up any old roots to prepare your border
 - 3. Choose your pollinator friendly plants. We recommend:



4. If you have a fence, wall or tree strump grow ivy and honeysuckle against it. Ivy flowers in autumn so it is a great source of nectar later in the year.
